## Obituary

On Wednesday, November 19, 2025, in the afternoon, God dispatched an angel to claim one of His own. Linda Faye Tuckerson Hall was born November 30, 1952, in New Orleans, LA. Linda was the first born of Paul and Elmira Tuckerson who preceded her in death. She confessed Christ in her life at six years old at Petty's AME Zion Church in New Orleans, LA under the leadership of the late Rev. A.W. Ricks.

After graduating from Xavier University of Louisiana in 1974 with a degree in Medical Technology, Linda accepted a position as a Quality Control Laboratory Analyst at The Upjohn Company/Pharmacia/Pfizer in Kalamazoo, MI and ended her career as a Clinical Scientist in the Clinical Research area. After her retirement from Pfizer in 2007, Linda started a promotional products business called Xcetera Plus.

Shortly after moving to Kalamazoo, MI and starting her professional career, Linda met her beloved husband, Stanley, through mutual friends at work. They married on April 3, 1976, and from this union were born Stanley Byron and Lesley.

Linda and Stanley loved to travel by air, land, or sea. They went on several cruises, the most recent, a Disney Cruise with daughter and granddaughter. One of the most memorable trips was when their firstborn was only 1-1/2 yrs old and they took a whirlwind road trip in their conversion van from Kalamazoo, to New Orleans, to Albuquerque, to The Grand Canyon, to LA, to Tijuana, Mexico, to Las Vegas, to Denver and back to Kalamazoo in 2 weeks.

While residing in Kalamazoo, Linda united with Allen Chapel AME Church where she served dutifully with the Women's Missionary Society and sang in the choir. She also served her community through Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc. where she held the status of Golden Life Member.

Not long after Linda gained the title of Grammy, she and Stan (now both retired), went to live with their daughter and granddaughter for a brief time in Keego Harbor, MI and were under the watch-care of Newman AME Church in Pontiac, MI.

In 2015, Linda and Stan moved into their forever home in Columbia, SC and became members of Reid Chapel AME Church where Linda once again joined the Women's Missionary Society and choir.
