# Obituary of Mr. Henry George Scott

Mr. Henry George Scott was born in Griffin, Georgia, on May 25, 1944, to Leanord Scott and Estell Toland-Scott. Henry moved with his parents to Columbus, Ohio when he was four years old. Henry attended Columbus City Schools. He attended Fairwood and Fulton Elementary, Mohawk Junior and graduated from South High School, in 1962. He graduated from Arkansas Agricultural Normal College in 1966 and received a master's in education degree from Xavier University, Cincinnati, Ohio, in 1968.

He married his cherished wife, Patricia Hallums-Scott, in June of 1972. Their union was blessed with one child, Khalilah Scott-Summers. The Scott family also welcomed a God sent son, Hassan Roberts.

Henry started teaching Special Education at East High School in 1969. He taught for four years before transferring to South High School, where he was the Assistant Basketball and Football coach. Henry went on to work as the Assistant Principal at Starling Junior High School, Linmoore Junior High and Linden McKinley High School. He accepted the principal position at East High School in 1987, where he served until retirement in 2002. Henry continued to support and develop younger administrators as he returned to West High School after his retirement. He remained at West High School until 2008.

Henry, known affectionately as "Scottie," was a proud member and Deacon at Mt. Olivet Baptist Church, Columbus, Ohio, where he led both Men's Ministry and the Married Couples Ministry under the pastorage of Dr. Charles E. Booth. "Scottie" was known as a trusted leader with a steadfast spirit. He was a man among men, one of one, and could always be depended on for wise counsel. "Scottie" was a true trailblazer that paved the way for many young people to see themselves as important and impactful. He led with his heart in all that he did.

He and Patricia moved to Columbia, South Carolina in 2017 to enjoy their retirement "down here in these Carolinas" (Henry's words). He loved the weather and the southern hospitality in his wife's home state.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Leanord and Estell Scott.
