Our mother was educated in the public schools of Richland County, South Carolina, where she graduated from C.A Johnson High School.

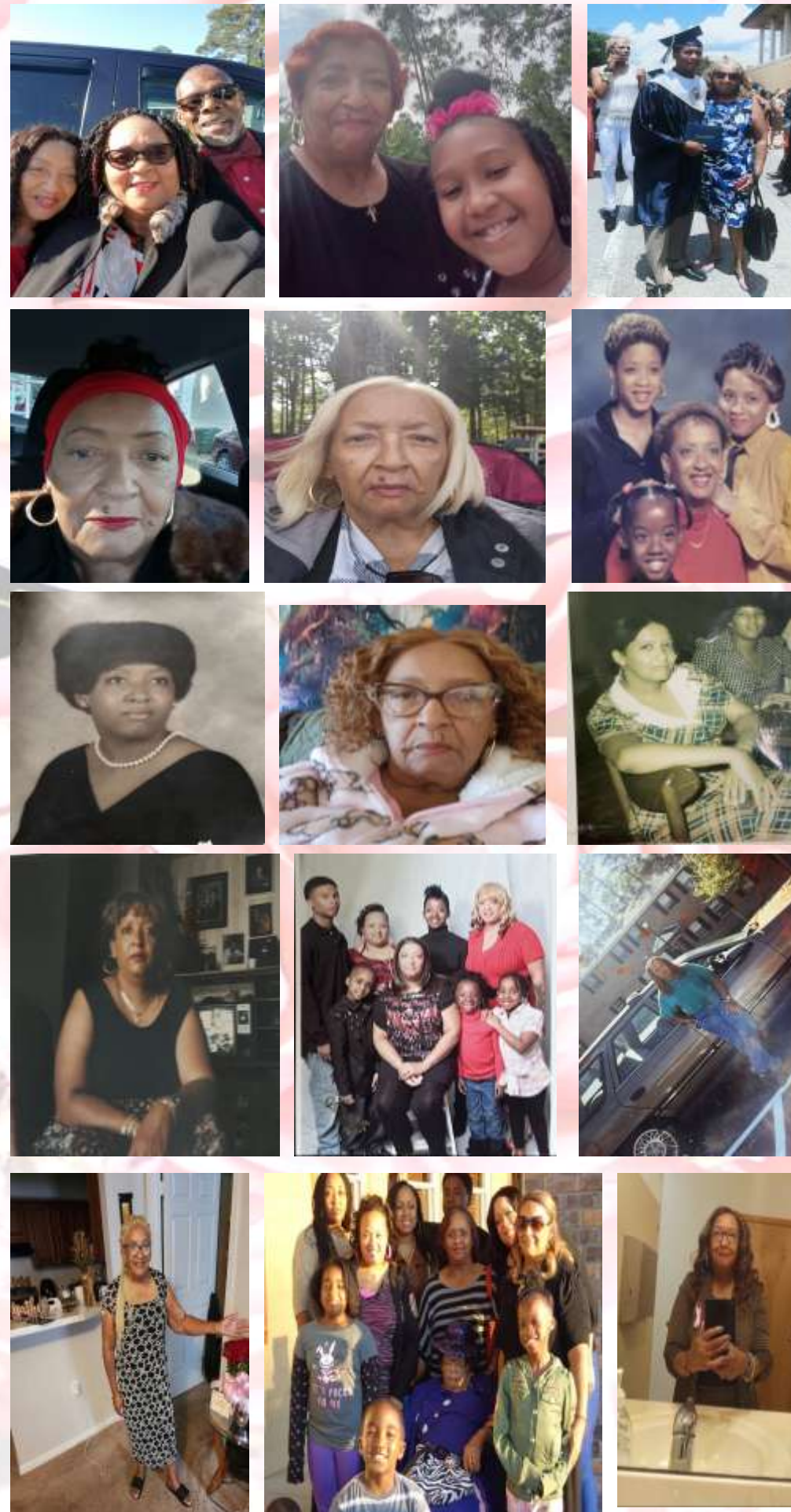
