# Obituary of Mr. Julius Cornelius Moore, Jr.

Mr. Julius Cornelius Moore, Jr., was born on August 9, 1975, in Columbia, South Carolina. He was the beloved son of Mr. Julius Cornelius Moore, Sr. of Winnsboro, SC and Apostle Margie L. Gallman of Aberdeen, North Carolina and Columbia, South Carolina. Affectionately called “JC”, “Pork Chop”, “Big Baby” and J, he departed this earthly life on Thursday, April 30, 2026, in the Lexington County Hospital. JC had been in the hospital suffering from complications due to diabetes and other health issues. His transition was so quiet, quick and peaceful, even the nurses were astonished. Before anyone knew, he exited this body and took on a new one, free from pain and suffering.

JC was educated in the Fairfield County Schools, graduating from Fairfield Central High School and later from programs within the South Carolina Vocational Rehabilitation Center. He was a consummate music and beats man, enjoyed the New York Yankees and loved his family fiercely. At the time of his death, JC was involved in the ACT Program and was determined to one day attend the University of South Carolina, JC refused to be limited in anything he wanted to do. He loved music, sports, cars, his clothes, hats and sneakers! His personality was engaging and his determination was infectious. He had dreams and goals and despite his setbacks, JC was determined to make it BIG!

JC attended his mother’s churches no matter where they were located, although his motivation was his weekly allowance, JC knew the power of God and His Word. He was philosophical, intelligent, sharp and quick-witted. Even after receiving a head injury in the late 1990’s, nothing could stop him once his mind was made up. He was compassionate, loving, determined, strong and helpful. He took care of others, denying himself and was committed to others long after they were gone out of his life. Once you met him, you couldn’t forget him!

He was preceded in death by his maternal grandparents, Ulysses and Sarah Lou Gallman and paternal grandparents, Louie Hicklon Moore and Mattie Rebecca Moore; and a paternal aunt, Carolyn Elaine (Moore) Belton.
