To Uncle Tim:

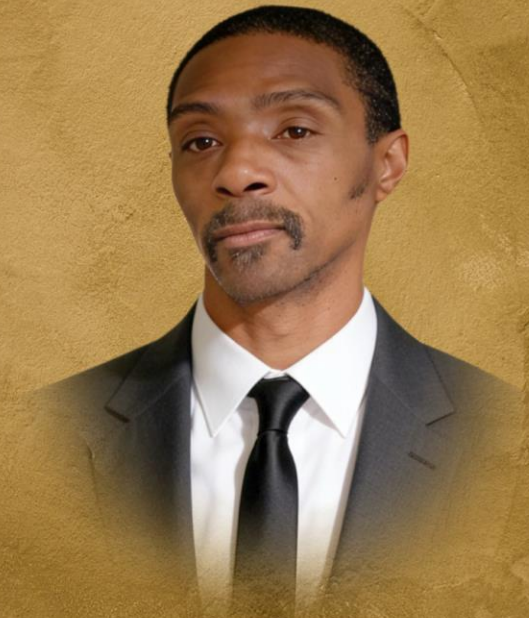
*A gentle soul, a heart of grace
