Bruce was a member of New Mt. Zion Baptist Church. His life reflected devotion to family, service to others, and a lasting commitment to his community.

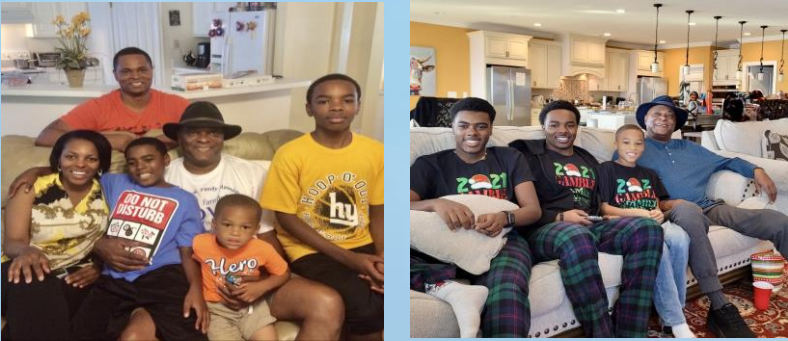
